# PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Read the manual prior to installation. Technical knowledge is necessary for installation. The place of installation must be free of moisture and away from heat sources. ## **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

1. Use a pair of hooks and insert them into the locations shown at the top corner of the air vents *(Fig. 1)* 



3. Use a panel removal tool to partially pull out and remove the air vent panel and then disconnect the connections to the hazard warning light (*Fig. 3*)

4. Fully remove the air vent panel by hand, pulling the panel forward out of the dashboard (*Fig. 4*)

# **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

5. Use a panel removal tool to loosen the lower fascia panel with pocket and then fully remove the panel by hand (*Fig. 5*)

6. Use a screwdriver to remove the four (4) Torx screws at the four located circled (*Fig*, 6)



7. Mount the two brackets to the sides of the aftermarket stereo and screw into place. Then mount the double DIN fascia panel onto the stereo/bracket assembly and screw to secure. (*Fig. 7*)

8. Make all wiring connections to the vehicle and push the double DIN stereo and fascia assembly into the dashboard until secure (*Fig. 8*)

Reinstall all other components in the reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.



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
